WATER RATE ORDINANCE AMENDMENT RESOLUTION NO. 2023-05

THE TOWNSHIP OF SWAN CREEK ORDAINS  
EFFECTIVE: June 1, 2023

**The Water Rate Schedule of the Swan Creek Township Water Rate Ordinance, Section 5, is hereby amended to read as follows:  
SECTION 5: RATES AND CHARGES**

FOR TOWNSHIP WATER CUSTOMERS:

Ready-to-Serve Charge per Quarter:

¾”	Meter	\$40.00
1”	Meter	\$60.00
1 ½”	Meter	\$80.00
2”	Meter	\$120.00
3”	Meter	\$600.00
4”	Meter	\$800.00
6”	Meter	\$1,600.00
8”	Meter	\$2,200.00

Consumption Charge per Quarter: \$5.65 Per 1,000 Gallons

QUARTERLY WATER BILL:

Ready-To-Serve charge for meter size and actual usage

FOR OUT-OF-TOWNSHIP WATER CUSTOMERS:

Rates will be the same as “Township Customers”

BULK WATER CUSTOMERS:

Bulk water rate: \$6.50 Per 1,000 gallons

TAP-IN CHARGE - \$4,250.00 for each connection


**Swan Creek Township Water Ordinance, Section 11, is hereby amended to read as follows:**

**SECTION 11:** No connection shall be made or permitted to be made to any water mains or fire hydrants of the water system without first obtaining a permit therefor. Application for such permit shall be made and filed with the township clerk, and the issuance of the permit approved by the township board or its authorized representative. At the time of connecting with the water system, the user shall pay a Tap-In Charge determined in accordance with “Water Rate

Schedule” appended hereto. All Service leads other than fire lines shall be metered. The meter shall be furnished and installed by the township and shall remain the property of, and under control of the Township. All meters are to be installed in a location suitable to the Township. Any authorized Township Employee shall, at all reasonable hours, have the right to enter the premises where such meters are installed for the purpose of reading, testing, removing, repairing, replacing, or inspecting the meter or for the purpose of inspecting any pipe or fixture connected to the Township Water System, and no such person shall hinder, obstruct, or interfere with such employee in the lawful discharge of his/her duties in relation thereto. The Water Superintendent shall have the right to shut off the supply of water to any premises where authorized employees are not able to obtain access to the meter. Actual cost of replacement for damaged or frozen water meters will be charged to the customer. A meter pit shall be required at the property line for all services greater than 200 feet in length. Such meter pit shall be installed by the customer in accordance with specifications furnished by the Township. All meter pits shall include a frost proof cover. The cost of installing such meter pit shall be paid by the customer. The maintenance of the customer service lead is entirely at the cost of the customer. In the event repairs, replacement or thawing of the customers service lead is required as determined by the Water Superintendent, the customer shall complete the repairs, replacement or thawing of the customer service lead at his/her cost within the time frame as allowed by the Water Superintendent. Failure to complete the work within the time frame shall allow the Water Superintendent to discontinue service to the premises. Swan Creek Township will not be responsible or liable for any damages caused by any leaks or malfunction of the water metering equipment.
